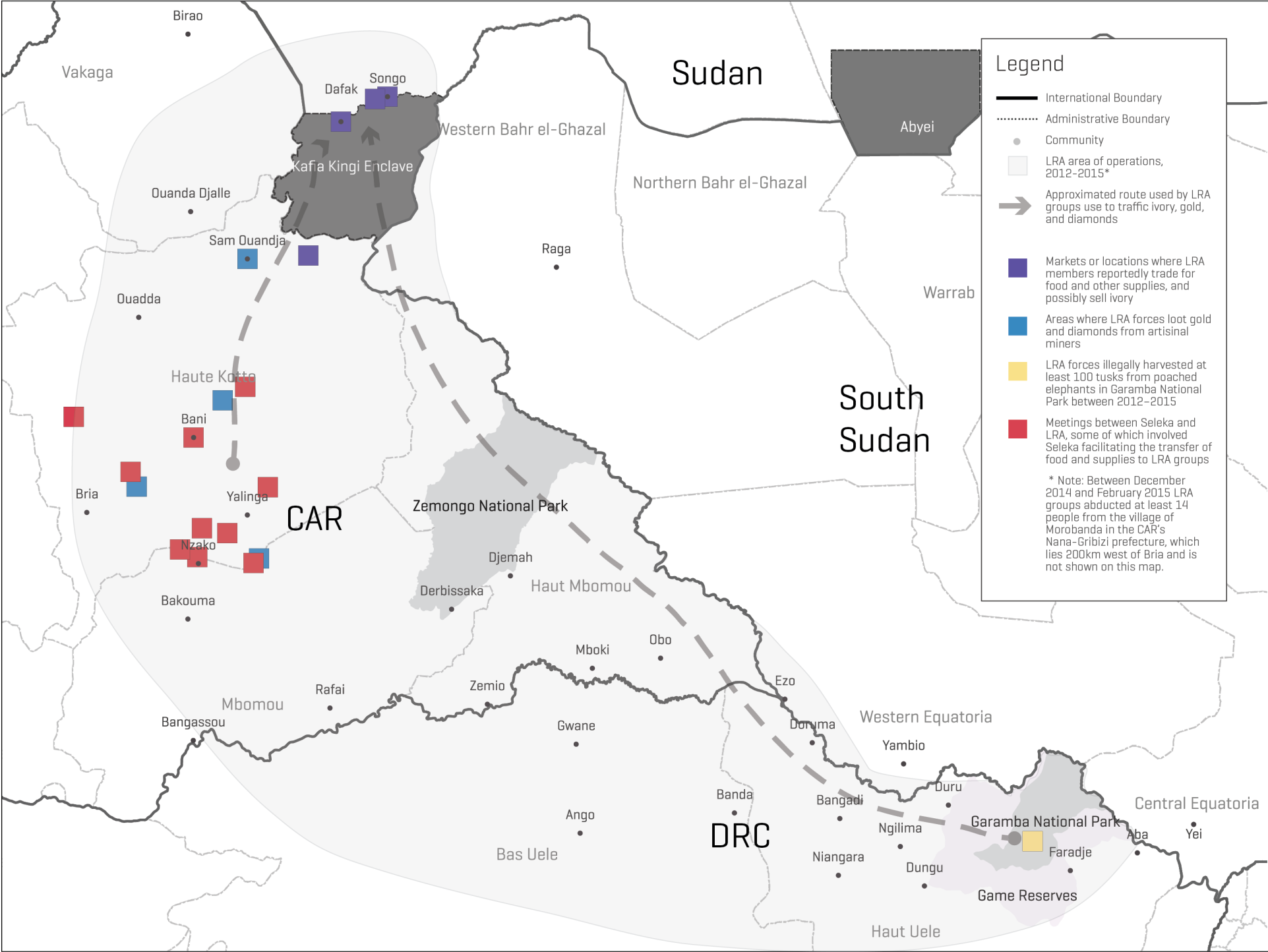


# LRA area of operations and trafficking networks

- LRA area of operations, 2012-2015\*
- Approximated route used by LRA groups use to traffic ivory, gold, and diamonds
- Markets or locations where LRA members reportedly trade for food and other supplies, and possibly sell ivory
- Areas where LRA forces loot gold and diamonds from artisanal miners
- LRA forces illegally harvested at least 100 tusks from poached elephants in Garamba National Park between 2012-2015
- Meetings between Seleka and LRA, some of which involved Seleka facilitating the transfer of food and supplies to LRA groups

\* Note: Between December 2014 and February 2015 LRA groups abducted at least 14 people from the village of Morobanda in the CAR's Nana-Gribizi prefecture, which lies 200km west of Bria and is not shown on this map.
